Horses/ponies may only compete in **one** class but may also participate in the Parade of Hounds. Horses/ponies must be paraded in the Paddock before their race.

Dogs on leads please.

To avoid endangering other competitors as well as your self please ensure that you and your horse are fit enough and that your tack and equipment are suitable for the event. (Think Team Chase/cross country **not Point to Point**)

Vet/Farrier fees incurred at the event are the responsibility of the competitor and owner. It is at the discretion of the professional supplying the service as to whether or not fees are payable at the time of treatment.

All riders **must** wear riding hats to the following standards PAS 015/ BSEN 1384/ASTM F1163 and back protectors BETA Level 3.

Liability

Neither the organising committee nor any of the sponsors shall be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Moreover by entering, every participant accepts this disclaimer and warrants the suitability of the entered horse/pony and rider to take part. All trophies must be returned by 10th March 2018 to the secretary.
A deposit of £20 will be required from winners that do not reside on the Isle of Wight

LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIRMAN. FEE £20.

ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE CORRECT ENTRY FEE AND SAE FOR PASSES

A DEPOSIT OF £5 WILL BE CHARGED PER NUMBER CLOTH. PLEASE BRING CORRECT MONEY

SAFETY LIMITS APPLY IN ALL CLASSES AND THEY WILL BE DIVIDED OR MERGED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIRMAN. THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO TRANSFER ENTRIES INTO THE APPROPRIATE CLASS AS REQUIRED. COURSE LENGTHS MAY BE ADJUSTED FROM THOSE STATED TO SUIT PREVAILING CONDITIONS ON THE DAY. ANY COMPETITOR WHO FALLS CANNOT CONTINUE OR RIDE IN ANOTHER CLASS UNTIL DECLARED FIT TO DO SO BY ON SITE MEDICAL PRACTITIONER

Declarations

All competitors are required to declare their intention to compete no later than 11.15 am. In cases of emergency or for competitors travelling from the mainland declarations may be made to the Secretary by telephone 07970 692240. Failure to declare by the specified time will result in exclusion from that class and forfeit of entry fee.
