All riders **must** wear riding hats to the following standards PAS 015/ BSEN 1384/ASTM F1163 and back protectors, current standard as approved by the Pony Club. (Hunt Ride to be appropriate Hunting Dress in Class 3).

General

Horses/ponies may only compete in **one** class plus Hunt Ride if desired

Horses/ponies must be paraded in the Paddock before their race.

No dogs allowed on the course.

Vet/Farrier fees incurred at the event are the responsibility of the competitor and owner. It is at the discretion of the professional supplying the service as to whether or not fees are payable at the time of treatment.

Liability

Neither the organising committee nor any of the sponsors shall be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Moreover by entering, every participant accepts this disclaimer and warrants the suitability of the entered horse/pony and rider to take part.
